<p>Obituary from the Portland Press Herald, Portland, Maine</p> <p>The Rev. Paul U. Pare, 75 BIDDEFORD - The Rev. Paul U. Pare, 75 of Marion Avenue died May 20, 2001 at St. André's Health Care Facility after a long illness.</p> <p>He was born in St. Hermenegilde, Québec, a son of Joseph and Aldea Audet Paré, and attended primary schools in Berlin, NH. He entered the Seminary of Joliette, Canada, graduated and entered the Grand Seminary in Montréal, where he studied philosophy and theology.</p> <p>He was ordained to the priesthood June 7, 1952, by Bishop Daniel J. Feeney at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Portland. He was assigned to St. Christopher's on Peaks Island, St. Agatha and St. Joseph's in Old Town, where he remained until 1959. Father Paré then became chaplain for the St. Ann Indian Reservation, Pleasant Point and St. John's Mission, Pembroke, and assistant for jurisdictional purposes at St. Joseph's Eastport.</p> <p>In 1967, he was named pastor of St. Mary's Eagle Lake, followed by assignments to St. Mary's in Lewiston, Notre Dame in Waterville and Notre Dame in Saco. He served briefly as administrator for St. Anne's, Dexter, and as temporary administrator for St. Matthew in Hampden and St. Gabriel, Winterport. His final assignment as pastor was to St. Francis de Sales, Waterville. Even after his retirement in 1992 he served as temporary administrator at St. Francis of Assisi, Belfast, and St. Rose of Lime, Jay.</p> <p>During his career, Father Paré served as chaplain of Immaculate Conception Circle, Daughters of Isabella and Knights of Columbus in Eastport; acting dean for Androscoggin County, vicar forane for Androscoggin County; Knights of Columbus chaplain in Waterville and the K of C Luke E. Hart Council of Biddeford.</p> <p>Father Paré enjoyed traveling and reading. He also enjoyed making pilgrimages all over the world, especially to holy sites. In his retirement he wintered in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.</p> <p>Surviving are a nephew, Paul P. Thibeault of Middleboro, Mass, four nieces, Jane Rossignol of Wells, Anne Carter of Oxford, Susan Legge of Cape Elizabeth and Elaine Bromfield of Rochester, NH.</p> <p>Visiting hours will be 2 to 4 and 7 to 98 PM Thursday at Hope Memorial Chapel, 480 Elm St., Biddeford. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 11 am Friday at St. Joseph's Church with the Most Rev. Joseph Gerry, bishop of Portland, as principal celebrant. Burial will be in St. Joseph Cemetery, Biddeford. Arrangements are by Hope Memorial Chapel, 480 Elm St., Biddeford.</p>
